2014 Dog Licenses



In accordance with Michigan Act 339 (The Dog Law), all dogs must be licensed at four months of age or older. Each Dog must be vaccinated by a certified veterinarian.

Oakland County dog licenses can be purchased at the Lyon Township Treasurer's Office, located at 58000 Grand River Avenue in New Hudson. You must bring proof of rabies vaccination. Please be advised that the Township cannot accept credit or debit cards.

Dog licenses must be purchased by June 1st so that they are not considered delinquent for the year. The dog license rates through June 1st are as follows:



Spayed or neutered: \$7.50

Not spayed or neutered: \$15.00

Senior rate (65 and older) – spayed or neutered: \$6.75

Senior rate (65 and older) – not spayed or neutered: \$13.50

Happy New Year from the Clerk's Office!

We are getting very excited because we are having two elections this year: the August 15, 2014 Primary and the November 4, 2014 General Election. We are in need of anyone who can work either election. Training is a must! You must receive a minimum of three hours of training prior to the election. Please fill out the application for Precinct Worker on our website and return it to April or myself at the office. You can find the application by clicking on the Applications link at <http://www.lyontwp.org/clerk>. We will start training in June.

A new election law does not permit us to give your absentee ballot to your spouse or parent. We used to be able to give the absentee ballots to anyone living at your address. Now we can only mail you your ballot or hand it directly to you after you submit your absentee ballot application. If you are unable to pick up your absentee ballot in person, please make sure you have enough time to mail in your application, have us mail you your ballot, and for you to return your ballot to us.

If you are the parent of a graduating senior this year who is going away to college, have them visit our office as soon as they turn 18 so they can register to vote in person. If we do not witness their ID, then they will need to vote in person the first time they vote. By witnessing their ID, we will be able to send them an absentee ballot when they are away at school.
