

2014 Dog Licenses



In accordance with Michigan Act 339 (The Dog Law), all dogs must be licensed at four months of age or older. Each Dog must be vaccinated by a certified veterinarian.

Oakland County dog licenses can be purchased at the Lyon Township Treasurer's Office, located at 58000 Grand River Avenue in New Hudson. You must bring proof of rabies vaccination. Please be advised that the Township cannot accept credit or debit cards.

Dog licenses must be purchased by June 1st so that they are not considered delinquent for the year. The dog license rates through June 1st are as follows:

- Spayed or neutered: \$7.50
- Not spayed or neutered: \$15.00
- Senior rate (65 and older) – spayed or neutered: \$6.75
- Senior rate (65 and older) – not spayed or neutered: \$13.50



Starting June 2nd, all dog licenses cost \$30.00.
