

## New Kroger Store Open


The former Hiller's grocery store on 10 Mile Road in Lyon Township reopened on Wednesday, July 22<sup>nd</sup> as a Kroger grocery store. In addition to the ribbon cutting event, the first 400 customers each received a \$10 gift card.

Although much of the store layout and product offering remains the same as Hiller's, a major change to the store is the addition of a Starbucks Coffee café shop. This is the second location for Starbucks in Lyon Township and a welcome addition to the 10 Mile corridor for morning commuters or as a gathering space to work or meet friends for coffee and more.

## Youth Group Visits Summerfest




## Out of Bounds

- Hole 1: On or over path left
- Hole 2: On or over path left, in O.B. Trap
- Hole 3: On or over path left
- Hole 4: On or over path right or long, in O.B. Trap
- Hole 5: On over path right
- Hole 6: In O.B. Trap
- Hole 7: On or over parking lot right
- Hole 8: No O.B.
- Hole 9: On road, in O.B. Trap
- Hole 10: On or over parking lot right
- Hole 11: On or over parking lot right, in O.B. Trap
- Hole 12: On or over road long or right, on or over path left
- Hole 13: On or over path left or long, in parking lot right
- Hole 14: On or over path right
- Hole 15: Must land in the "island". If not, go to the drop zone with a one-stroke penalty. If you don't land in bounds from the drop zone, go back to the drop zone with a one-stroke penalty.
- Hole 16: On or over road right
- Hole 17: On or over path left or long, on or over parking lot right
- Hole 18: On or over road left or past basket, on road/path short of basket

**Rocks are out of bounds. Part of your disc must be touching the in bounds side of the rocks to be in bounds.**






### Genealogy

## News from the Lyon Township Clerk's Office


