Fire Marshal Graduates



On October 23, 2015, Lyon Township's Fire Marshal Don Collick graduated from the Eastern Michigan University's School of Fire and Staff Command.

This course is designed to prepare the professional fire officer to effectively manage their fire agency. This management-oriented program consists of 350 hours of competency-based education spread over 10 months. The program takes the fire officer beyond traditional operation methods and exposes them to conceptual thinking and problem solving.

The EMU School of Fire Staff and Command education/training program targets those fire officers destined for senior leadership within their departments. With technology advancing at such a rapid rate, senior fire officers must be prepared with the knowledge, skills, and abilities afforded private industry, which are often ignored in public service.

Township Supervisor Lannie Young, Fire Chief Ken Van Sparrentak, Deputy Fire Chief Doug Berry, and Don's family were in attendance at his graduation. Congratulations, Don!



Join us as we make terrariums and dish gardens from recycled materials. We will supply everything, but feel free to bring your own container. Please RSVP.





Genealogy Round Table – Friday, November 13th from 1:00 to 3:00 p.m.


Meet up with fellow genealogists to discuss your family history, share hints, and ask questions. We will also talk about databases and other useful resources.




