

Application for Lyon Township Minor Home Repair Program 2016

The Charter Township of Lyon has established a program to provide grants for minor home repairs to low income households within the Township. A limited amount of grant money will be available and is distributed to eligible households based on the following guidelines:

- The home must be a single family, owner-occupied dwelling located in Lyon Township.
- The household must qualify as a “low income household” under current HUD guidelines.
- The repair must be necessary to maintain the health, safety and welfare of the occupants.
- The repair is estimated to cost less than \$5,000.
- No household may receive more than \$10,000 in a lifetime.

When more applications are received than money is available, preference will be given based on the following criteria:

1. **Emergency Repairs:** Applications for emergency repairs to make the home safe and prevent further damage (e.g., leaking roof or broken furnace) will be considered before all other applications are considered. If there are more emergency repair applications received than money available, preference will be given based on the need for the repair at the time of application.
2. **Income:** Unless the application is of an emergency nature, applications from “extremely low” income households will be considered first, followed by “very low” income households second and “low income” households third.
3. **First-Time Applicants:** Unless the application is of an emergency nature, any household who has received a Minor Home Repair Program grant in the past will be considered after all other first-time applications are considered.
